Job Summary: Responsibilities fall outside the school day, such as evenings, weekends, holiday breaks, and summer breaks.

We expect:

- Conduct computer inventory quarterly
- Basic maintenance of Chrome books, staff laptops, SmartBoards
- SmartBoard assistance as needed
- Teacher computer assistance as needed
- General technology maintenance – communications with Schiller for hardware repair
- Scheduling and preparation of technology dissemination for instructional purposes
- Creation and maintenance of a school-wide technology process/procedure
- General upkeep, including charging
- Student Gmail updates, including creating users
- Delivery of computers for student/teacher use
- Monitoring Chrome book use by students
- Technology updates as needed for all laptops
- Technology resources for teachers as needed and by request
- One-on-one training for educators as requested, and depending on availability for technology resources
- Attend technology committee meetings
- Alignment of all student usernames for all interfaces (MobyMax, Renaissance Learning, Gmail, etc.)
